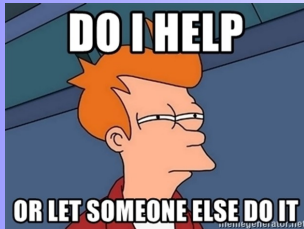

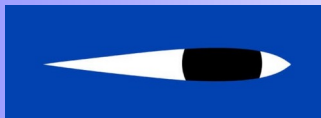

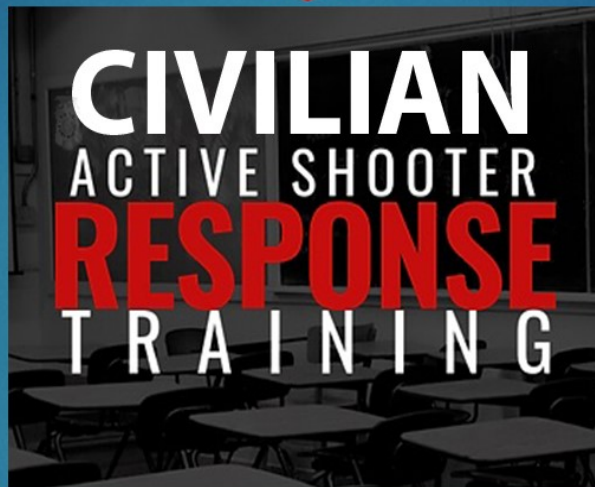

UNSOLVED CRIME - ARSON



**ARSON FIRES AT FWISD SCHOOLS
FORT WORTH FIRE DEPARTMENT**

The Fort Worth Fire Department's Arson / Bomb Division is asking for the public's help for any information about several fires that occurred on FWISD's property **on Thursday 9/24/20 and Friday 9/25/20.**

On Thursday 9/24, a male suspect set two fires at two different Fort Worth ISD schools. The first fire was set at Versia Williams Elementary at 901 Baurline Street. The suspect then set a fire a short time later inside Maudrie Walton Elementary's library at 5816 Rickenbacker Place.

Then on Friday 9/25/20, the same person then started fires in the FWISD Administration building, maintenance facility, and several other locations in the West 7th area.

If you have information that can help to identify a suspect (s), please contact the **Fort Worth Fire Department Arson Investigations Unit** at 817- 392-6869.

If you have information on these unsolved cases, please contact **Crime Stoppers** by calling 817-469-8477, submitting a web tip through www.469tips.com, or through the mobile app by downloading P3 Tips. You will remain anonymous. Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$1,000 for information that leads to the arrest of the person responsible for these crimes.

Deaf Link is an all service interpreting agency providing Video Remote Interpreting Services (VRI), Pre-Recorded ASL Interpreting (PRI) and the Accessible Hazard Alert System (AHAS). www.deaflink.com



The City of Fort Worth is partnering with Deaf Link to provide the Accessible Hazard Alert System (AHAS) which will send accessible alert messages to registered residents who are Deaf, Blind, Hard of Hearing, or Deaf/Blind before, during, and after an emergency or disaster in the City of Fort Worth.

Fort Worth AHAS subscribers in an area affected by an emergency or disaster will be able to receive an accessible alert message in American Sign Language (ASL) and English voice and text. The alert message could include information about the emergency and what actions to take.

Fort Worth AHAS will send accessible alert messages to internet and video capable devices such as computers, cell phones, smart phones, tablet computers, and wireless Braille readers.
